We would like to put an A3 brass plaque up in the Roland King Room in his memory so that people in the future know why the room is so named. The wall selected is part of the modern kitchen addition.

Churchwarden from 1957 to 2016.

There are already two similar historic brass plaques in the Roland King Room. These are on the wall below the West Window however we thought it might be preferable to fasten the plaque to a modern wall rather than the older part of the building. If the DAC prefers, we can put this plaque alongside the others, one of which also marks the service of a churchwarden.


The plaque will be mounted using screws.
